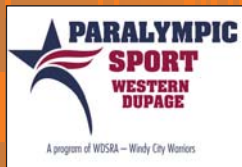

Paralympic Sports

WDSRA is proud to be a Paralympic club offering developing and elite athletes access to the United States Olympic Committee (USOC) Paralympics.



To see if you are eligible to participate in any of the WDSRA adapted sports programs, call (630) 681-0962 and ask for a member of the adapted sports team.

Adapted Sports

Adapted sports are designed to give the recreational or competitive athlete the ability to participate to the fullest extent possible. Programs are designed to increase an athletes mobility in a variety of sports. WDSRA provides access to instructional, high school, and league sports.

Are you eligible?

Adapted sports are available to children and adults who require modification to participate in sports activities due to any physical limitation or disability.

If you have *any limitation on your physical movement* you may be eligible for adapted sports. Physical movement limitations may include but are not limited to knee, hip and foot injuries.



If you have a *physical disability* you may be eligible for adapted sports. Physical disabilities may include but are not limited to amputations, muscle disorders, traumatic brain injury, stroke, spina bifida, and cerebral palsy.



In some sports, wheelchairs are used to create an equal playing field for those with limitations on the lower extremities. *Anyone with a physical limitation can participate.*

WDSRA can loan adaptive equipment for those interested in testing a new sport.
