

**ORDINANCE NO. 25-01**

**ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE  
CODE OF CONDUCT FOR  
WDSRA PROGRAMS AND VISITORS**

**WHEREAS**, the Western DuPage Special Recreation Association, DuPage County, Illinois, has a Mission Statement of "We enrich lives, connect communities and create fun through inclusive recreational opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Western DuPage Special Recreation Association endeavors to make WDSRA's programs and facilities safe and enjoyable for everyone; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors and staff wish to ensure that all individuals participating or volunteering in a WDSRA program or activity, attending an event, or using WDSRA facilities exhibit appropriate behavior at all times; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WESTERN DUPAGE SPECIAL RECREATION ASSOCIATION, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section One:** The Board of Directors of the Western DuPage Special Recreation Association has determined that the Code of Conduct for the agency is:

Western DuPage Special Recreation Association requires that all participants, parents, staff, volunteers and guests comply with the following basic behavior. All participants, parents, volunteers and guests shall:

1. Show respect for all participants, parents, staff, volunteers and guests.
2. Refrain from using abusive or foul language.
3. Refrain from threatening or causing bodily harm to self, other participants, guests, volunteers and/or staff.
4. Refrain from causing damage to property of others and WDSRA assets, such as equipment, supplies, and facilities.
5. Represent WDSRA in a manner that is consistent with the goals, objectives, and ethics of the Association.

**Section Two:** That the Association Board hereby authorizes staff to remove a participant, parent, volunteer, or guest from a program, event, or facility if they fail to comply with the Code of Conduct.

**Section Three:** Participants, parents, volunteers and guests are required to make themselves informed and aware of this Behavior Code of Conduct, as well as any other rules and behavior expectations developed for specific programs, events, parks and facilities as deemed necessary by WDSRA.

**Section Four:** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by a three-fifths majority of the members of this Board of Directors.

**Section Five:** All prior ordinances, resolutions, motions, orders, or policies in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed to the extent of the conflict herewith.

**Section Six:** If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction or by operation of any applicable law, it shall not affect the validity of any other clause or provisions, which shall remain in full force and effect.
