# KEEPING SERVICES FLOWING

On Wednesday, October 4, 2023, we experienced a catastrophic water main break at the WDSRA office, resulting in approximately four inches of water flooding the entire building. The flood affected all common areas, offices, closets, and the Rec & Roll room, forcing an immediate evacuation. Items not destroyed by the water were moved to temporary storage. With the support of our Park District partners, the Carol Stream Rec & Roll group and staff were quickly relocated, and a plan was implemented for a combination of remote and in-person solutions.

Throughout the entire situation, our priority remained ensuring that every program continued as scheduled, with no interruption in services.

# FY23-24 in Review

### ORGANIZATIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

- The Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting was awarded by the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada for comprehensive financial reporting
- A water main pipe break forced the temporary closing of the WDSRA office, staff transitioned to a hybrid remote work setup, ensuring no interruption to programs or services

### PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Summer Day Camp statistics: served 81 unique campers with 126 registrations, offered 6 camps consisting of 12 sessions, offered 6 Field Trip Fridays, held at 6 locations, included dozens of local locations visited
- New programs included: partnering with Peoples Resource Center for more Cultural Arts programming, a WDSRA Polar Plunge special event, and a weekly BUNCO program

- Trips returned with a weekend in the Dells, overnight in Chicago, and spring break in Mexico
- The **Disability Awareness** program was updated to include activities and a new guidebook
- To improve privacy & security while eliminating paper forms, ePACT was implemented with families

### ATHLETICS HIGHLIGHTS

- Special Olympics athletes competed in 19 regional and state events across 13 sports. Representing 36 teams and 100 individuals entries, they earned over 145 medals and numerous ribbons
- WDSRA hosted the first Pickleball Classic at the Wheaton Sports Center with 30 athletes and 15 volunteers
- Launched the Special Olympics Jr Wildcats program with basketball and soccer for ages 8-15

- Launched the youth sports program with basketball, tball, and soccer for ages 7-15
- Synergy Adaptive Athletics joined forces with Lincolnway Special Recreation Association to provide more competitive opportunities for our basketball athletes
- Synergy Adaptive Athletics
   partnered with the Paralyzed Veterans



# Challenge to Triumph

### **LUKE'S STORY**



Luke is a boy with a BIG personality—sociable, affectionate, and funny. From a young age, he always strived to keep up with his twin sister and older brother. Luke's mom, Jana, believed it was crucial for him to be around his typically developing peers both in and out of school. While school provided the necessary support, Luke needed additional help to keep up and stay focused outside of it.

Living with Down Syndrome and anxiety, Luke can be a complex individual. He requires time to warm up to people and process his surroundings, a need that can be challenging for his peers to understand. Though he loves being part of a team, the journey was challenging.

That's when the family turned to WDSRA Inclusion.


WDSRA's inclusion support staff helped Luke manage his anxiety during programs, make transitions smoother, engage with his peers, and grow more independent.




