

Rec & Roll Eligibility Criteria

Rec & Roll 1 Staff: 6 Participant Ratio Criteria (NAP, CS, GE and WTN)

- Independent with all daily living skills
- Independent with personal care and have good hygiene
- Communicate basic wants/needs using various forms of communication
- Actively participate in a variety of planned activities
- Able to follow verbal multiple step directions
- Positively cope with changing schedules
- Appropriately interact and be socially engaged with peers for the duration of the day
- Devoid of emotional/physical outbursts
- Ability to de-escalate in an appropriate time frame
- Responsible for keeping track of, carrying, and identifying personal belongings
- Able to successfully navigate the community including staying with the group, having appropriate behavior and interactions with community members
- Ability to keep pace with the group
- Flight risk prohibited

Rec & Roll 1 Staff: 3 Participant Ratio Criteria (FV and FH)

- Complete daily living skills with minimal assistance
- Basic personal care and good hygiene is required
- Must be independent with toileting including wiping and applying feminine products. Staff assistance may be given with clothing manipulation, prompting, and transferring
- Must be able to wash hands or use hand sanitizer with verbal or visual prompting
- Communicate basic wants/needs using various forms of communication
- Ability to follow 1-2 step directions with either verbal/visual prompting
- Attempt participation in a variety of planned activities and remain in the proximity of the group for the duration of the activity
- Ability to adapt to a change in schedule without a negative behavior- notice will be given in various forms
- Able to tolerate engagement with a group of peers for an extended period of time
- Able to successfully attend field trips within the community
- Appropriately interact with various members of the community
- Devoid of physical outbursts
- Devoid of emotional outbursts after implementing de-escalation skills
- Ability to identify personal belongings with minimal prompting
- Ability to keep pace with the group
- Flight risk prohibited

In the event that a participant is displaying the ability to meet higher criteria or is struggling to meet the criteria listed above, they may be reevaluated. This can include the possibility of moving to a 1:6 ratio, to a 1:3 ratio, or being dismissed from the program. Not everyone qualifies to participate in Rec & Roll. WDSRA reserves the right to reevaluate participant's ability to successfully function within the Rec & Roll ratio at any time.
